Open data is being used in this sector to evaluate and improve educational outcomes, help parents and students make more informed educational choices, and provide technical training. The most used data types include education, demographic and social, and government operations.

HOW ORGANIZATIONS USE OPEN DATA

Organizations in the education sector use open data to:

- Provide students and parents information on the cost and quality of educational institutions to help them make better choices
- Evaluate educational outcomes and government spending on education
- Conduct analysis of schools based on population density, access to services, mobile penetration, and other factors
- Improve students' technical and data literacy and skills, by using it as a resource to analyze, visualize, and interpret real data around issues relevant to students' communities and interests




